Dear BCSSSD Parent/Guardian:

This letter is to inform you of the most recent guidance we have received from the BCDOH and NJDOH regarding travel advisory and quarantine updates as we move toward Spring Break in April. This will be important to know prior to approaching our Spring Break.

In accordance with their guidelines, New Jersey strongly discourages all non-essential interstate travel at this time. At this time, **individuals who have been vaccinated against COVID-19 should continue to follow the State's travel advisory.** Click here to read the [CDC Travel Advisory](#).

Travelers and residents returning from **any U.S. state or territory** beyond the immediate region (**New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Delaware**) should self-quarantine at their home, hotel, or other temporary lodging following travel. Click here to read the [Travel Restrictions To and From New Jersey](#):

- If travel is unavoidable, travelers should consider getting tested with a viral[PCR] test (not an antibody test) 1-3 days before the trip and again 3-5 days after the trip.
- If travelers test positive, they should **self-isolate for at least 10 days and should postpone travel during that time.**
- If travelers test negative, they should **quarantine for a full 7 days after travel** or test between day 5 and 7 of their return to the state and can return to work with a negative test.
- If testing is not available (or if the results are delayed), travelers should **quarantine for 10 days after travel.**

It is our hope that as we progress through the year, restrictions will be lifted or ameliorated as more have been vaccinated. Thank you for your ongoing support and collaboration.
